

## Application for Comprehensive Examination, Spring Semester 2026

We would like to inform you of the details regarding the Comprehensive Examination for the Spring Semester of 2026. Students who wish to take the examination administered by each department must apply within the designated application period.

- 1. Eligibility:** Students who have earned at least 18 credits in major courses, maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher, and have received their faculty advisor's recommendation. (The faculty advisor will process the application via AIMS.)
- 2. Application period:** **March 11 (Wed), 2026, 09:00 - March 13 (Fri), 2026, 23:59**
- 3. Procedure:** Login to the Portal → Academic Affairs Information → Grade/Graduation (upper menu) → Comprehensive Examination Application (left menu)
- 4. Date of exam:** To be announced by each department in March~April
  - Please refer to your department's notice board for details.
- 5. Passing Criteria:** 60 points or higher out of the total of 100 points for each degree program
  - If failed to pass, re-taking of exam is possible regardless of number of tests taken
- 6. Study subject for examination**
  - Master's program: Major I , Major II
  - Doctorate program and integrated program: Major I , Major II
  - \* Detailed subjects and schedules may vary by department. Please inquire with your department.
- 7. Checking Results (Online)**
  - Procedure: Login to Portal → 'Academic Affairs Information' → 'Grade/Graduation'(on the upper side) → 'Comprehensive Examination Application'(on the left side))
- 8. Important Notes for Applicants**
  - Before applying, please confirm your test eligibility and prior results online.
  - Applications must be submitted strictly within the designated period. Late submissions will not be accepted. (The schedule may be subject to change depending on circumstances, and any changes will be announced on the website.)
- 9. For Students in the Integrated Master's-Doctoral Program:**
  - If you intend to be awarded a Master's degree, you must take the Master's examination.
  - If you transferred from a Master's program to the integrated program, you must take the Doctoral examination.
